Summary The Manufacturing Assistant Intern will be responsible and able to shift between work stations and assignments in all areas of the Production department including but not limited to: Packaging line (all stations), Shipping, Receiving, Blending, Maintenance, Laboratory work and Special projects. This position will be supervised by the Production Manager with close collaboration of the Purchasing & Logistics supervisor. The Manufacturing Assistant is responsible for assisting the Production Manager and P&L Supervisor in various technical and administrative tasks as outlined below.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Perform repetitive workstation or assembly line operations to mass produce liquid filled bottles and assemble components for finished product.
- Package finished bottles inside boxes and load onto skids for distribution.
- Responsible for the safe operation of equipment in accordance with standard operating procedures.
- Maintain work area and equipment in a clean and orderly condition and follow prescribed safety regulations.
- May work at different workstations as production needs require, or shift from one station to another during the assembly process.
- Assists Production Supervisor in monitoring production schedule
- Assists quality control and supervisors with work kit preparation
- May handle administrative tasks as assigned by supervisor
- Acts as a liaison between different areas of production
- Ensures that all the raw materials are stocked in appropriate quantities
- Making available to the workers required machineries and equipment's
- Support the shipment of goods produced, goods received and supplies to be used in or to aid in the production/storage of goods destined for sale to our customer base.
- Report defective materials or questionable conditions to Logistics Supervisor.
- Ensure all manufacturing safety regulatory policies and procedures are implemented and maintained at all times.
- Make certain first in/first out procedures are applied on a regular basis.
- Perform order selector duties as part of department job rotation: pick and pull products from the warehouse as indicated per job orders and assemble pallets for shipment to the customer base.
- Straps and wraps all outgoing orders for shipment.
- Examines outgoing shipments to ensure shipments meet specifications.
- Maintains inventory of shipping materials and supplies.
- Performing several other tasks as required.
